A whole church reading, praying, and reflecting on the same passages of Scripture every day. One chapter at a time. Beginning with a prophecy of the Messiah and his first coming. Ending with a resurrected King ascending to heaven, to await his second coming. Twenty-four days. Twenty-four chapters.

We can make it happen! Join us this December to read Good News of Great Joy! Beginning December 1, you're invited to read one chapter of Luke every day through Christmas Eve. By the time we gather for our Christmas Eve service, we'd be overjoyed to say all of Crossing had read the Gospel of Luke together. 2. What kind of response did this chapter evoke? Reflection, worship, repentance? Something else? Why?
3. What does this chapter make you look forward to when you think about Jesus's second coming?
